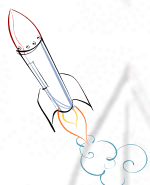
Cowtown Brush-up (Boy Scout, Venturing & Cub Scout district event)

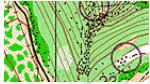

U.S. Cavalry Living History Camp (Boy Scout and Venturing council event)

Cub-O (Cub Scout council event)



- Jan 2nd, 2010 at Sid Richardson Scout Ranch
- Cub-O is a fun Orienteering competition for Tiger Cubs, Cub Scouts, and Webelos held each year right after the holiday break. Approx \$16 per participant includes patch and map. There were 2,629 Cub Scouts and parents who participated in Cub-O 2008 - *now the largest orienteering event in the history of North America!*
- Each team of 3-6 Cubs gets a Cub-O map half an hour before the race starts. The map shows the location of 40 or more orange and white orienteering flags out on the camp. You and your boys look over the map and plan a strategy to find the most flags and score the maximum point total possible in 2 hours! Each flag has a pin punch that you punch the scorecard with. The Orienteering Committee will conduct map training sessions for Cub Scouts and parents all morning.
